

Resolutions of the Board of Directors of Priests for Life at Board meeting of February 27, 2014

Board Resolution 14-01

It is the sense of the board that in some way, a larger, interdenominational, civilly incorporated pro-life organization with international reach -- such as Gospel of Life -- would be the umbrella under which Priests for Life and its related ministries should function. Priests for Life already identifies itself as "An Outreach of Gospel of Life." In the coming months the Board, at its own pace and in consultation with the experts on whom it relies, will discern how this relationship should be defined.

We have no doubt about our mission and its various branches. We seek simply to find the best structures, and the best relationships between those structures, both in the civil and ecclesiastical arenas, to protect, promote, and fund that mission.

Board Resolution 14-02

The organization Priests for Life has in the course of the last three years been subject to various unfortunate attacks and, to defend itself, has taken recourse within the Church to preserve its good name and proper functioning.

At the same time, the organization has enjoyed the esteem and support of the leadership of the pro-life movement and of countless activists around the world.

In the course of these events, the leadership of Priests for Life has received a significant amount of guidance and advice from Church leaders -- including non-binding recommendations from the Vatican -- as well as professionals who are experts in various fields, as to what can assist the organization to become stronger and more effective in the future.

The board recognizes the importance, therefore, of both considering this advice and at the same time not being rushed into decisions that lack sufficient reflection and additional consultation.

Therefore we are resolved that the board, officers, and other trusted advisors will enter into a period of discernment and reflection, at our own pace, leading to decisions regarding whether, in addition to its corporate status, to seek additional status under the canon law of the Catholic Church.


Board Resolution 14-03

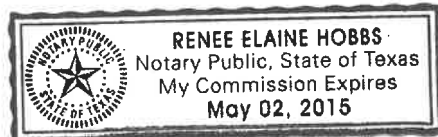
Board Resolution 14-04
